## Overview

Within this year the students will be looking at drawing together all their dance knowledge from the previous year to complete the third and final component.

## Term 1

In this term the students will complete Component 2 – Developing Skills and Techniques in the Performing Arts. In this component the students will learn a piece of professional repertoire linked to a theme previously set by the exam board. They will take part in workshops and rehearsals to prepare for a performance. At the end of the process the students will review their own development as well as the final performance.



## Term 2

In this term the students will start by developing their choreography skills. They will be introduced to many different styles of choreography which will prepare them for Component 3. The students will then begin to work on Component 3 – Responding to a Brief. In this component the exam board set the students a brief to create a performance using a theme. The students will work in groups to develop a piece of dance which would be suitable for this brief. Throughout the term the students will record their progress in assessment conditions

## Term 3

In this final term the students will be preparing for their final performance and their final evaluation. All work for this component is completed by the middle of May.
