- What you normally do on holiday.
- What you like / dislike doing on holiday.
- Describing the journey (in the past).
- What you did on holiday.
- Accommodation where you stayed (and opinions about it).
- Weather.

Umwelt

- What you do / have done / plan to do / should do to help the environment.
- Wide range of verbs in all tenses and interesting ideas to go with them.

- What are the main problems facing society?
- What can you / we do about them?
